The Society's principal aim is to promote concerts of the highest artistic standards. As a registered charity and a non-profit making organisation, its financial contribution to concerts could not be made if it were not for the generous assistance by private individuals and commercial organisations.

The Chorus of the Leeds Philharmonic Society is a leading choir in Europe, where it regularly tours, singing to professional standards with internationally renowned soloists, orchestras and conductors. As well as giving concerts in Leeds at the Town Hall, Leeds Minster and St Anne's Cathedral, the Chorus has toured and performed in many other prestigious venues including: Bridgewater Hall (Manchester), Symphony Hall (Birmingham), The Sage (Gateshead), Liverpool Metropolitan Cathedral, Ely Cathedral, the Liszt Academy Budapest, Stephansdom in Vienna, the Konzerthaus, Dortmund and St Anne's Cathedral, Belfast.

The Chorus has the privilege of working with the outstanding conductor, **David Hill**, our Choral Director now for several years, and have been led in rehearsals by our very talented Chorus Master, **Joseph Judge**, since 2018.

Who are the Friends of the Phil?

Friends are lovers of choral music who wish to support the continuation of this vital part of the cultural life of Leeds. Some are current or former singing members of the Society; others are relatives/spouses/friends of members and of course from among our audiences.

What are the benefits of being a Friend?
